

1 STRUCTURE OF A SERIAL NUMBER

A serial number consists of the date of production, purpose of use of a product and the current number as follows:

2 MEANING OF INDIVIDUAL MARKINGS

2.1 Year of production

The marking of the year of production consists of a one digit number representing the last figure of the year concerned as shown in Table No.1, and is repeated every 10 years.

2.2 Week of production

The marking of the week of production consists of a two digit number representing the number of the current week in a calendar year as shown in Table No.2.

2.3 Purpose of use of a product

The marking of the purpose of use of a product consists of a one digit number defining the purposes the product will be used for.

Table No. 3: Purpose of use of a product

Symbol	Purpose of product application
1	Products returned in repair due to transport and handling damages, quality complaints and unmarketable inventories. The product shall not get new identification number; order for repair is created.
2	Products of evaluation.
3	Products from regular production.
5	Products returned in reprocessing. The product shall get new

	identification number. Differential Parts List and work order for reprocessing shall be created.
6	Samples of products intended for laboratory, logistic or some other testing procedures within the scope of the program are recorded in the Logistic warehouse .
7	Samples of products bough from competitors.
9	Samples of products for potential customers, samples for fairs and show-rooms, samples intended for diverse measurements carried out by external institutions, samples for households (users' measurements) and samples of prototypes are recorded in the Logistic warehouse .

3 EXAMPLES OF MARKING PRODUCTS WITH SERIAL NUMBERS

a) Example of marking products from regular production

100 pcs of washing machines PS0A3/140-WA614SYW GOR with ident. number 276297 and 200 pcs of washing machines PS0A3/140-WA614SYB GOR with ident. number 276327, produced in 20th week in the year 2010, shall be marked with the following serial numbers:

02030001 to 02030100 for PS0A3/140-WA614SYW GOR and
02030001 to 02030200 for PS0A3/140-WA614SYB GOR
