<u>Issue:</u>

Customer complaint of Icemaker not working, icemaker is frozen over with ice. May also include complaints of a large block of ice and iceicles forming around the icemaker



<u>Repair:</u> Follow the Steps Below

1. Begin by removing all ice build up from the ice maker unit. Then on the rear of the unit; mark the BLUE water line with a black marker at the point it enters the cover. Then remove the phillips screw and remove cover.

2. Remove retainer to allow for easier movement and pull out the BLUE water line.

4. Reinstall the the line and reassemble the unit. NOTE: The original line mark you made is back in the original position.

3. Measure 7 3/4 inches (~19.5cm) from the mark you

5. Ensure all ice build up has been removed. Inspect the ice maker fill tube and insure it is aligned correctly. If it is at an angle twist into the correct position. If not fully insert pull the tube into the correct position as shown in the picture.
